

## This is BankID

BankID is a form of e-identification that enables companies, banks, organisations and agencies to identify, and enter into agreements with private individuals through the internet. BankID is an electronic ID document that is comparable to a passport, driving licence or other physical identification document.

## This e-identification is issued by the banks

Any private individual who has a Swedish personal ID number can obtain a BankID through his/her bank. A BankID has the same value and is used in the same way regardless of which bank issued it.

## BankID is widely used

Banks that issue BankIDs to private individuals include Danske Bank, ICA Banken, Ikano Bank, Handelsbanken, Länsförsäkringar Bank, Nordea, SEB, Skandiabanken, Sparbanken Syd, Swedbank and Ålandsbanken. In all, these banks have 8 million internet banking customers who have the ability to use BankID in internet- and mobile banks, and with public agencies, municipalities and private companies. In 2017, it is estimated that BankID will be used nearly 2.5 billion times.

An overwhelming majority of those who use e-identification today have chosen BankID. Other issuers of e-identifications include Telia, for example.
